

TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE

Associate of Arts in English at UC Clermont College to a Bachelor of Arts in English at Northern Kentucky University

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the Associate of Arts (AA) in English degree at UC Clermont College and leads to the Bachelor of Arts (BA) in English degree at Northern Kentucky University (NKU).

To earn a degree at UC Clermont, a student must complete a minimum of 61 credit hours, attain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0, and earn a minimum of 20 credit hours at the institution awarding the degree.

Students completing an associate degree with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher will be accepted into NKU.

To earn a bachelor's degree at NKU, students must complete a minimum of 120 credit hours with at least 45 credit hours numbered 300 and above. In addition, at least 25% of the credit hours required for the degree and the last 30 credit hours must be completed at NKU. Students must have an overall GPA of 2.0, earn a C or higher in each course used to fulfill the major or minor requirements, and meet all prerequisites for courses and requirements for the major. All English majors are required to demonstrate (1) intermediate-level proficiency in a foreign language previously spoken or used to satisfy the NKU entrance requirement or (2) novice-level-proficiency in a second foreign language. Students can demonstrate intermediate-level-proficiency by either completing the appropriate 200-level course in the language studied in high school or by attaining an acceptable score on the CLEP test in that language. Students can demonstrate novice-level-proficiency by completing two semesters of a language not previously studied or spoken. Students must complete a focus or minor as indicated on the pathway.
